

We began with a full building analysis and set forward with the following project:

- Complete Optimization and Replacement **HVAC Systems**
- Total Retrofit of the Lighting Systems, complete with Motion Sensors
- **Energy Saving Window Film**
- Installed Energy Management System to control HVAC, Water, and
- control kW demand through the **Energy Management System**
- Added a 140kW Photo-Voltaic Array to generate about 67% of our **Electrical Consumption**
- Water-Free and Pint-Flush Urinals, Flow Faucets
- Developed and Installed Water-Sub-Metering and Trending System to identify Internal vs. Irrigation water usage
- Set Water Consumption Alarm Systems for Leak Monitoring
